Gypsy is a 13.1HH Welsh/Arab bay mare.

She was born prematurely to a starving mother. As a result, she is permanently compromised with severely angled pasterns and stunted growth. (At 13.1HH she is a hand smaller than her expected height of 14,2HH)

Gypsy can never be ridden due to her multiple skeletal issues, but over time and with therapy, she has become perfectly paddock sound and a beloved companion to Kiah.

She was surrendered by a young lady who had rescued her from a questionable breeder but did not have the means to help her.

Gypsy is so delicate, so refined, and so exquisitely beautiful. She had extreme behavioral issues when she first arrived and it was very difficult to trim or handle her feet, which needed urgent attention due to a large abscess on her nearside fore.

Her flight response was phenomenal and she had a pathological fear of wet concrete.

Gypsy was clearly deprived of a mother figure in her early years and adopted Kiah instantly.

She rarely leaves Kiah's side and the two mares have formed a deep bond.

Today, Gypsy is adorable - a curious, affectionate, intelligent and trusting little pony with a heart of gold and wins the hearts of all who meet her.
